Word For Your Week is designed for you to continue the conversation through the week with your children. Each week you will have opportunities to connect during Meal Time, Drive Time and Bedtime.

Talk about ways you can help those around you. Maybe it's a neighbor, family member or friend. Make a plan and do something to help someone this week!



**Bedtime** - Read John 14:15-16 NCV. "If you love me, you will obey my commands. I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper to be with you forever." What do these Bible verses teach us about the Holy Spirit? Pray and thank Jesus that when He left this earth, He sent the Holy Spirit to help and guide us.



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
