WRECK THE ROOF: WEEK 2

While anyone can take time to answer these questions individually, these questions are best discussed in a group! Not in a group yet? We want you in one! Head over to southeastchristian.org to join a group in person or online, wherever you are - today!

Has there ever been an opportunity in your life that you regret letting pass by? Why didn't you seize that opportunity when it was presented to you? Why has that decision stuck with you? How has it impacted the way you viewed subsequent opportunities?

Read Acts 2:42-47. As you read these verses, what sticks out to you about the early church? What were these first Christians like? How did they treat one another? What would have drawn you into this first congregation? Why? What would it look like today for a church to grab hold of these same qualities?

Kyle reminded us that Kingdom opportunities can sometimes look like obstacles. Think of a time when God used an obstacle in your life for His purposes. What happened? What was that like? What are some ways we can keep our eyes open for those opportunities even in the midst of our difficulties?

How important was generosity in the early church? Look back at Acts 2:42-47 and circle all the phrases that speak to their generosity. In what ways were they generous with one another? How can our generosity create Kingdom opportunities in the lives of others? How can our generosity help prioritize the Kingdom in our own hearts?

According to Acts 2:47, who was responsible for the growth of the early church? What does this tell us about whose power drives the church forward? What happens when we start to think that we can do it under our own power? What do we miss out on when we try to do it on our own? How can we, as a Group, encourage one another to live in the power of the Spirit?

As Kyle said, one word you hardly ever hear the Spirit say is "Tomorrow." Why are we so tempted to procrastinate when we see what the Spirit wants from us? How have you seen this in your own life? Pray as a Group that God would give you each hearts that are receptive and obedient to the opportunities He puts in front of you this week.
