Would you rather play a team sport or participate in a sport where you only compete as an individual? Why? What are some of the pros/cons of each? How does being a part of a team create accountability? How does this relate to our duty to “spur one another on”?

Spurring something forward requires proximity and provocation. Why are both of these things essential? Can you think of a time when someone spurred you forward? How did that make you uncomfortable? How did that make you feel valuable? In what ways did that interaction change your life?

Read Hebrews 10:19-25. Circle all the phrases that speak to what we have because of Jesus. Which of these gifts is the most significant to you? Why? How do these blessings empower us to encourage one another? How do they motivate us to spur one another on?

Bryson talked about some of the false pictures we can have of our heavenly Father. Which of those pictures resonated the most with you? What are some other false Ideas people have about God today? How can we remind each other of who God really is and what He wants for and from us?

What keeps us from having difficult conversations with other believers? What's your biggest obstacles to initiating (or even inviting) these kinds of conversations? How can focusing on eternity make us more willing to spur one another on in this way?

Who is spurring you on? Is there anyone in your life who has the permission to do this for you? Who do you need to spur? Whose life are you speaking into right now? What do you need to do to build relationships where these things happen?
