CREATING MOMENTS TO DISCOVER GOD, HIS STORY, & OUR PLACE IN IT

Word for Your Week is designed for you to continue the conversation through the week with your children. Each week you will have opportunities to connect during Meal Time, Drive Time and Bedtime.

A prophet was someone who called the people to love and obey God and wrote down God's words for His people. God told Elijah to choose a man named Elisha to continue his work as a prophet. You can read this true story in 2 Kings 2.



Meal Time - Go around the table and talk about a time when you were chosen to do an important job. What was the job? Who taught you how to do this job? How did you know you were ready to do this job on your own?

Drive Time - Have someone read 2 Kings 2:9-15 or listen to it together on a Bible app. Elisha was given an important job, but he wasn't alone. Elisha had God's Spirit with him to help him. How do you think Elisha felt, knowing that even though his friend was gone, God's Spirit was with him, helping him? Talk about it.



Bedtime - When we accept Jesus, God gives us the Holy Spirit to help us follow Him. Read together these Bible verses about the Holy Spirit: John 14:26, Romans 8:26, and John 16:13. Pray and thank God that He sent the Holy Spirit to help us follow Him every day.

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
