WRECK THE ROOF: WEEK 6

While anyone can take time to answer these questions individually, these questions are best discussed in a group! Not in a group yet? We want you in one! Head over to southeastchristian.org to join a group in person or online, wherever you are - today!

What is your favorite verse in the Bible? Is there a story behind why you chose this verse? Why is this verse so significant to you? How does it help remind you of the Gospel? What practical difference has this verse made in your life?

What happens when a business loses sight of its mission statement? What happens when a church loses sight of its mission and calling? Have you ever seen something like that happen? What was that like? How does the Word of God help keep us on mission with one another?

Read Acts 13:16-44. As you read, circle or underline every time you see other Scriptures quoted in this passage. How many times did Paul quote the Scriptures? How did Paul use Scripture (particularly the Old Testament) to talk about Jesus' death and resurrection? What does this teach us about the Old Testament and how it points to Jesus? How does all of Scripture help us to know Him?

Acts 13:44-45 talks about two different reactions to the preaching of the Word. What did these two reactions look like? How do we still experience these same reactions today? Why do you think God's Word creates two such opposite reactions in people?

Read 2 Timothy 3:14-17. According to Paul's words in this passage, what is Scripture good for? What does it accomplish in our lives? How should this change the way we approach/apply it to our lives? How have you seen God's Word do these things in your own life?

Carl reminded us that the foundation for a move of God is dedication to the Word of God. What are some practices that have been helpful in getting you more into God's Word? Identify some practical tips you can share with other members of your Group. How can you all encourage and challenge one another to spend more consistent time in Scripture?
